

Reward Program:

- Students earn a sticker for completed homework and class-work if all:
 - Has the student's name, date, and the start/finish times
 - Is completed without any skipped problems or pages

Home Grading

The Kumon Program encourages, and recommends that all homework be home graded as it benefits to both parent and child:

- Students advance to new material sooner with fewer errors and less repetition
- Students progress 30% to 100% over those who do not home grade
- Allows the child to learn immediately from mistakes
- Encourages children to work harder

Why so much repetition?

Many parents question the repetitive nature of Kumon. There are numerous reasons behind the repetition of worksheets:

- It is a natural part of the mastery process and Kumon worksheets prompt children to apply each concept until it is fully grasped
- Applying skills repeatedly is precisely what reinforces them and ensures that they're permanently retained
- A key aspect that facilitates your child's progress toward becoming a better learner

Registration

How do I enroll my child?

To enroll your child in the KUMON program the following steps must be completed:

- Visit the Kumon Center for an introductory information packet
- Enrollment Orientation
- Placement Testing: tests are administered to students by appointment
- Forms: The following forms must be complete, signed, and turned in:
 - Application
 - Notice to Parents
 - Registration Procedure & Fee Schedule

Tuition

What is the cost?

- **\$75 Per Month Per Subject** (Math and/or Japanese)
 - For example, If your child takes both Math and Japanese the cost of tuition would total \$150 for each month
- Tuition is due by the 25th of each month
- **Cash Only (No Checks, Credit, or Debit Cards)**
- There are no partial monthly payments. Tuition for the whole month is due, even if your child does not attend class (However, homework will be provided for unattended classes)

Class Policies

- Allow for at least **30 minutes per subject**
- If your child is not able to attend class, please notify us ahead of time to receive homework
- If you are planning to take a vacation, please inform us in advance by filling out the Advance Notice Sheet
 - Thus student will receive sufficient homework for time missed to avoid breaking the Kumon routine or progress
- Kumon is a quiet learning environment
 - No food or drinks
 - No cell phones or iPods



Withdrawal Policy

A 30 day written notice by the first of the month is required to withdraw students from the center. Due to the unique nature of the Kumon program, casual or seasonal enrollment is strongly discouraged.
