


| Pre-readers under age 3 and their caregiver | Mother Goose on the Loose | Tuesdays 10:30 am | Join us for this gentle but fun introduction to reading. Library staff will model pre-literacy skills such as singing songs, learning finger plays and nursery rhymes, and one-on-one reading for you with your child. Parents should expect to sit on the floor with their child and interact directly with them. <u>BabyTime</u> is 20-30 minutes of bouncing, bubbles, and bursts of laughter!
